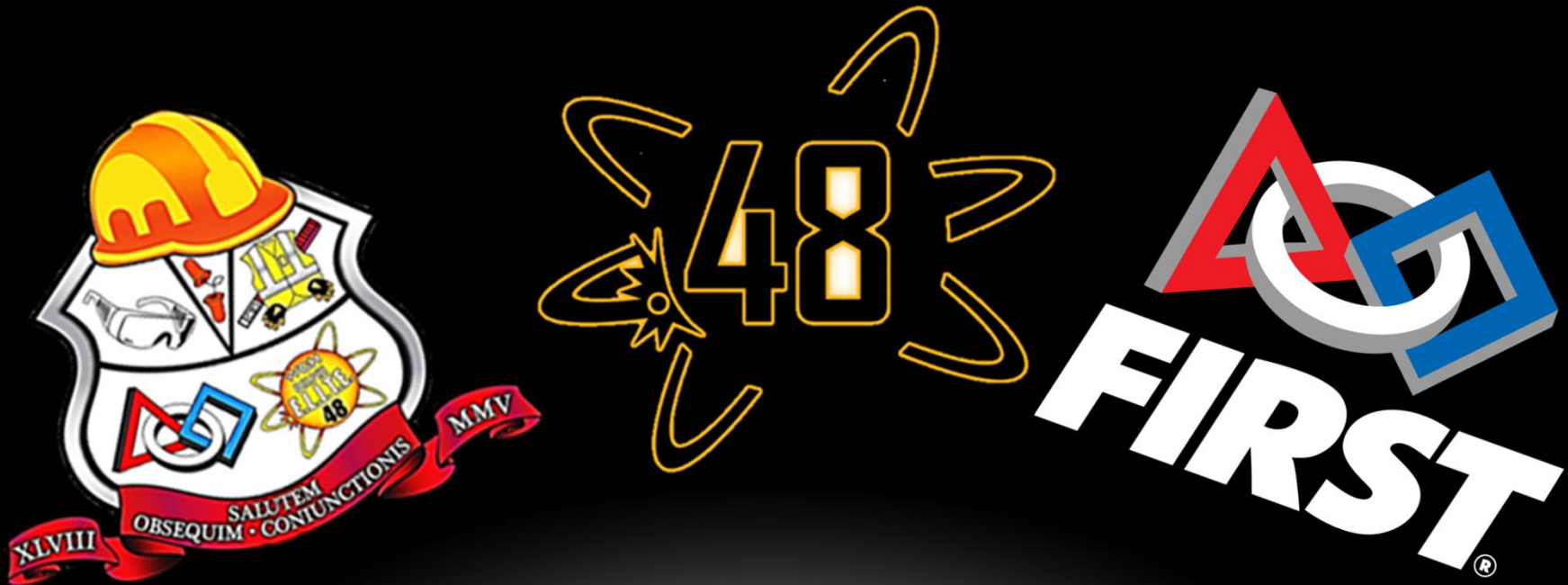

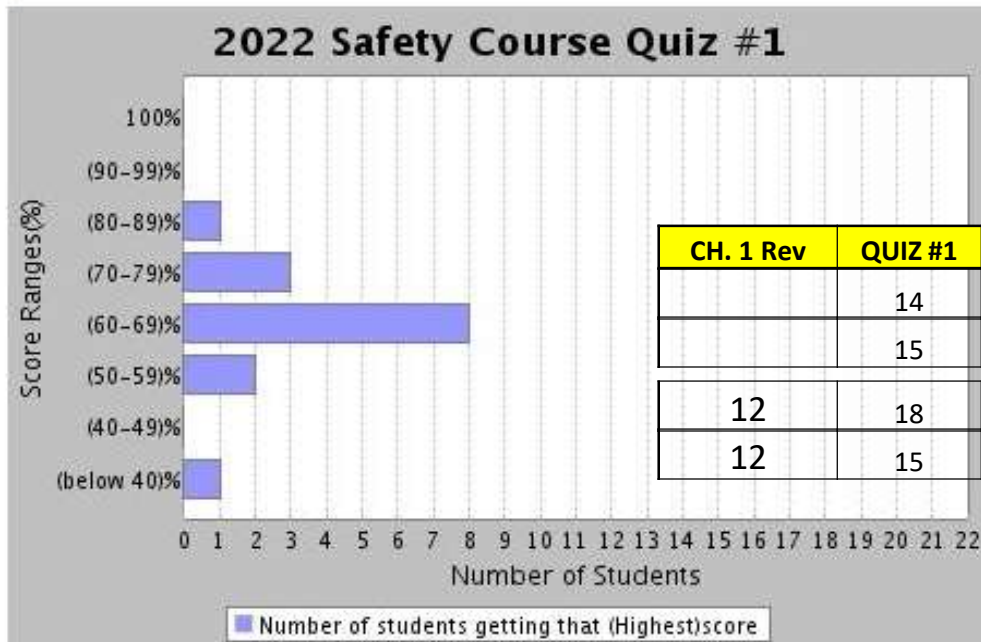

# CLASS #3 ACTIVITY

## Documentation and Reporting

- **Near Miss Form**

*\*A Team 48 student accidentally knocks over a rack of T-Handles, which knocks over a container of nuts, bolts and washers in our robotics cage in the metal shop. The student does not do a very good job of cleaning up the mess and Travis comes in later and slightly slips on some of these small parts. He blars about it for the rest of the night and then again on several Slack posts.*

- **Incident Report Form**

*\*Late one night during a shop day, a few mentors and a student are hanging around the shop when one mentor gives the “choking” sign just as they pass out and collapse. The mentor hits his head on a fire extinguisher as he falls and the impact on the ground causes a piece of food to loosen and get coughed out of his mouth. The mentor wakes up disoriented and a bit angry and embarrassed but recovers enough that no medical attention is needed.*
